PAPER FORMAT GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSON

- Time table for submissions
 Submission of abstract: by 5th June 2015
 Authors have to submit their full-length papers in the following format by 15th June 2015.
- 2. Format of paper All papers must be consistent in format and layout as follows: Papers must start with a title page but showing only:

Title:	Bold centered 14 point Arial
Author(s):	Name, Position, Organisation
Contact details:	Full address, Phone, Fax, Email, Website (if any)
Author's Bio-data:	Author should provide their biographical details, not more than 100 words
Abstract:	Between 250-300 words
Keywords:	Up to 5 keywords to be provided for indexing, cataloguing in classification purposes
Originality statement:	Author(s) must write a line about the originality of research paper and permission to ITHC for the publication of same.

There should be no author identification after the title page. The page following the title page should show only: Title, then the abstract within the paper, then the main text.

Main text:	Minimum 3000 maximum 6000 words – including tables, figures and references – single-spaced.	
	 All photographs should be in High Resolution (More than 200 dpi) JPEG format. Authors must try to fit in all the tables to the end of paper. 	
Page numbering:	All pages should be numbered in footer in the bottom center of each page.	
Headers:	Please leave empty so that we can add the conference title, date and location to every page.	
Citations and references:	Harvard style.	
	References in the text should be cited by the author's name and year of publication in brackets e.g. (Binota, 2014: 16).	

	Where there are two or more references to one author for the same year, the following form should be used: (Tribe, 2001a), (Tribe, 2001b).
	Where references include three or more author the form (Cooper et al., 2007) should be used.
	A full list of references including all authors in alphabetical order should be given at the end of the paper. References should conform to the following convention:
